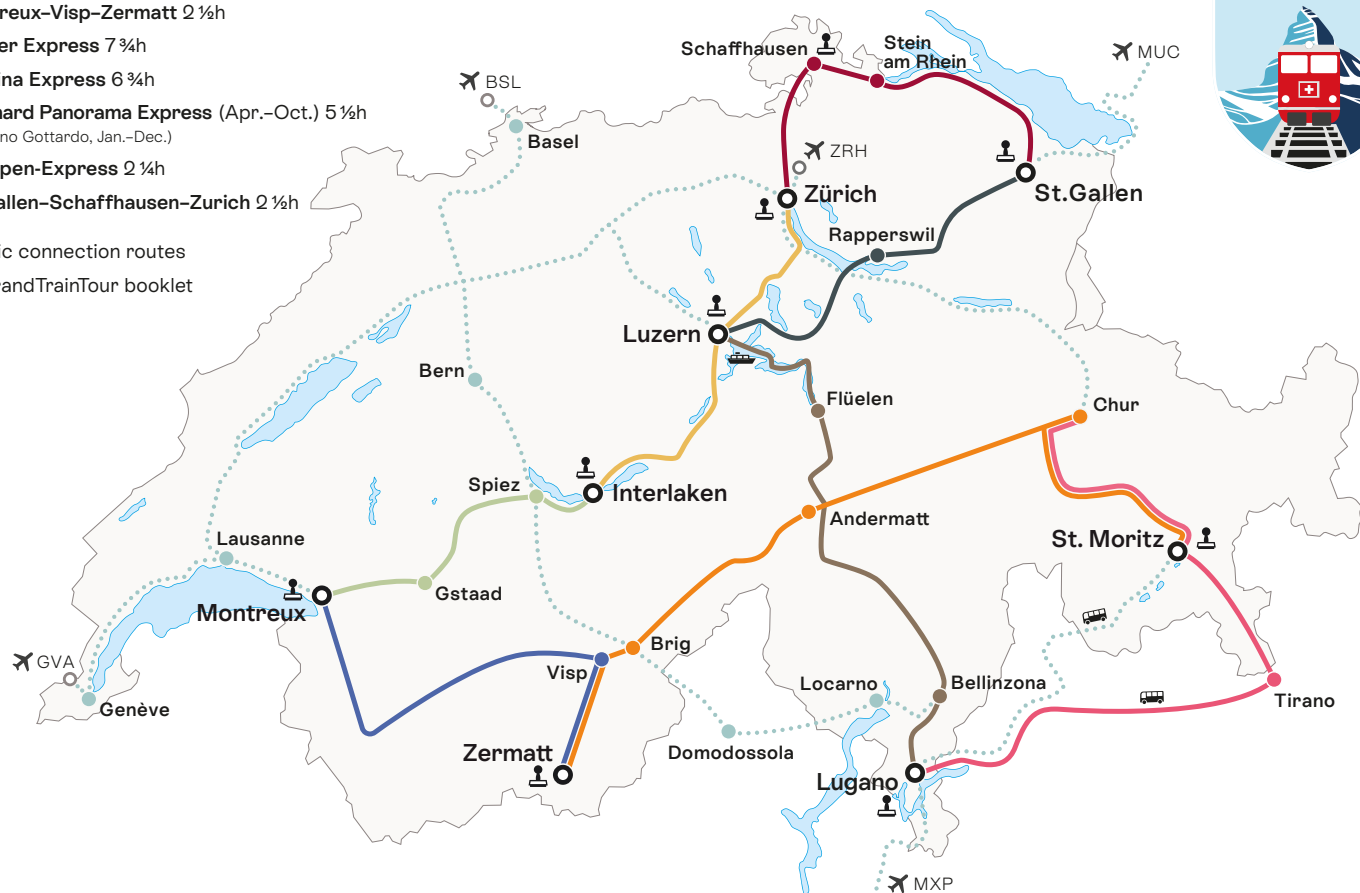

The Grand Train Tour of Switzerland merges all the panoramic journeys into one breathtaking route. All year round, this 1,280-kilometre train ride takes you from the prettiest Swiss towns to Alpine villages, through UNESCO World Heritage sites, and past world-famous sights.

Stages

Zurich–Lucerne–Interlaken Lucerne–Interlaken Express

2¼h | The journey from Switzerland's urban centre to Lucerne is dominated by sparkling lakes and gently rolling hills. Nature lovers will be thrilled by the journey in the Lucerne–Interlaken Express in particular – thanks to the mountain panorama and countless waterfalls.



Interlaken–Montreux GoldenPass Express

3¼h | The GoldenPass Express takes you past magnificent castles and grazing cows. This comfortable panoramic train runs directly from Interlaken to Mediterranean-style Montreux, crossing the French-German linguistic border.



Montreux–Visp–Zermatt Matterhorn Gotthard Bahn

2½h | Valley after valley: this journey takes you through the Rhone Valley and then the Matter Valley – Switzerland's deepest. The Matterhorn Gotthard Bahn climbs some 900 metres in altitude on its journey from Visp to Zermatt and the famous Matterhorn.



Zermatt–St. Moritz Glacier Express

7¼h | The Glacier Express takes you through the Alps, connecting glitzy Zermatt with the equally glamorous St. Moritz. Ceiling-high panoramic windows offer unobstructed views of imposing mountainscapes, deep gorges and picturesque valleys – scenic splendour at its finest.



St. Moritz–Tirano–Lugano Bernina Express

6¼h | By the time the first glaciers sparkle through the train windows after Morteratsch, few if any passengers are still in their seats. One highlight follows another on the journey over the Bernina Pass and down to Tirano. And you can enjoy even more beautiful scenery on the Bernina Express Bus to Lugano.



Lugano–Flüelen–Lucerne Gotthard Panorama Express

5¼h | From April to October, the Gotthard Panorama Express takes you from Mediterranean-style Ticino to Flüelen via the Gotthard panorama route. You then board a boat to cross Lake Lucerne and reach the city of Lucerne. Alternatively, the Treno Gottardo runs directly from Ticino to Lucerne every hour all year round.



Lucerne–St. Gallen Voralpen-Express

2¼h | The Voralpen-Express departs from Lucerne against the backdrop of Lake Lucerne and the prominent Alpine panorama of Central Switzerland. This journey guarantees views of spectacular peaks followed by the lake dam at Rapperswil with a view of the castle and the lake, and finally the Sitter Viaduct – Switzerland's highest railway bridge.



St. Gallen–Schaffhausen–Zurich, Thurbo Seelinie

2¼h | The route from St. Gallen to Zurich revolves around one particular element – water. Like Lake Constance and the Rhine, the spectacular Rhine Falls never cease to amaze. Thanks to the semi-circular routing of the railway, you get a perfect view of Europe's largest waterfall right from the train.

Scenic connecting routes

St. Moritz–Lugano

4h | The Palm Express is an alternative way to travel from the Engadin to Ticino. Unlike the Bernina Express Bus, it also runs in winter. On the route from St. Moritz to Lugano, the yellow postal bus crosses the Maloja Pass and then winds its way through Val Bregaglia to Italy. Glaciers and palm trees on the same journey.



Spiez–Domodossola (IT)–Locarno

4¼h | The RegioExpress Lötschberger and the Vigezzina-Centovalli Railway take you past fabulous views. Marvel at the Kander Viaduct and the view of the Rhone Valley on the Lötschberg mountain route and take in the stunning vistas of deep gorges and rugged mountains in Centovalli.



Chur–Zurich

1¼h | When you travel directly from Chur back to Zurich, you experience the most beautiful views of the Bündner Herrschaft, the Churfirsten, Lake Walensee and Lake Zurich.



Arrival from Geneva/Basel

Scenic routes take you directly from Basel or Geneva to the Grand Train Tour of Switzerland. Enjoy unique vistas while travelling along the shore of Lake Geneva with a view of the UNESCO-listed terraced vineyards of Lavaux and on the route through the Jura & Three-Lakes region.

More space and first-class service – for an exclusive travel experience.

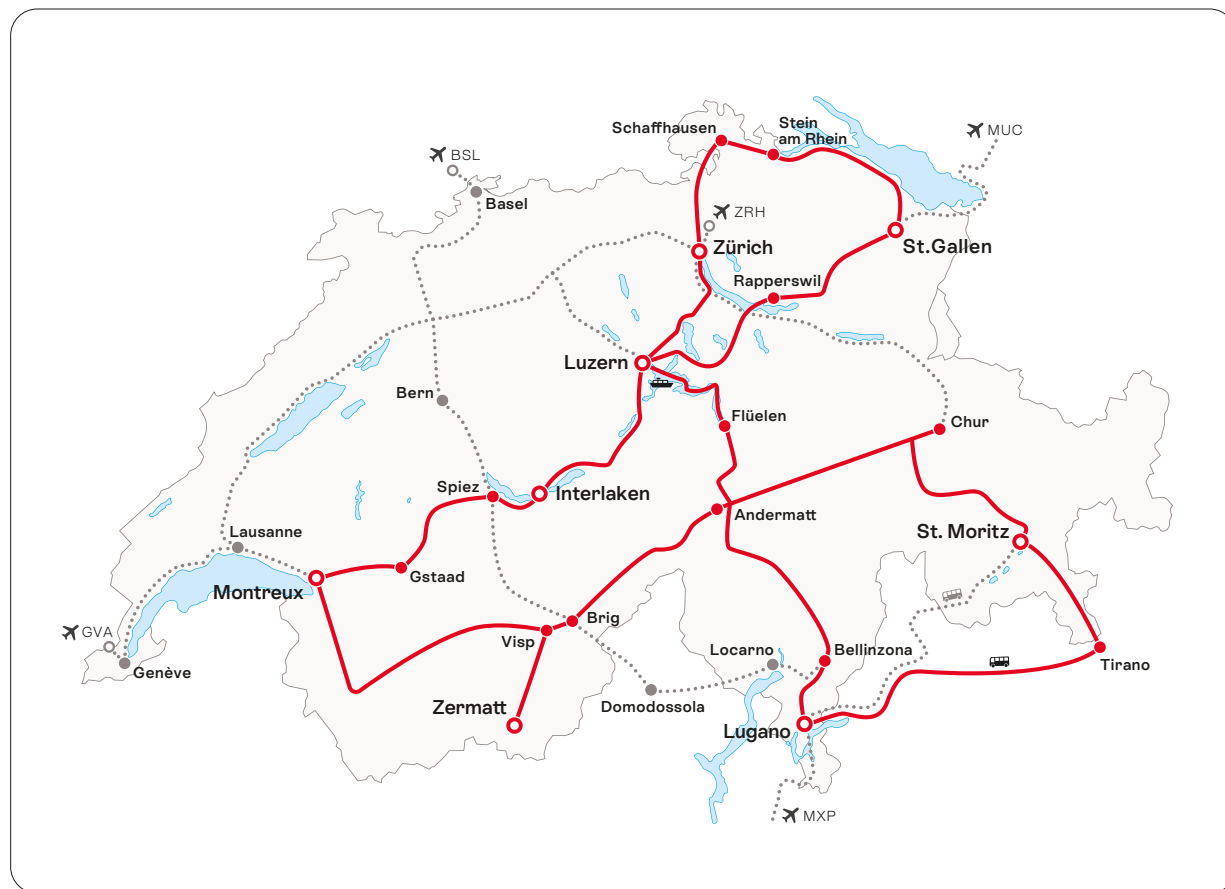

Glaciers & Palm Trees

From 4 days / 3 nights | This tour delivers on its promises. Starting from moderate climates, the train climbs to over 2,000 metres above sea level. At first, the view through the ceiling-high windows alternates between imposing glaciers and magnificent mountain lakes. Shortly afterwards, the train winds its way down towards Italy, where you can continue on to Lugano by bus – immersing yourself in a little dolce vita before heading to Lucerne via the historic Gotthard Line.

Reservations and surcharges

A seat reservation and/or surcharge is required to travel on some trains, buses and boats, including the Glacier Express, Bernina Express, Gotthard Panorama Express and Palm Express. Seat reservations are recommended for the Lucerne–Interlaken Express and the GoldenPass trains. Further information can be found on the website of the respective transport company. Package prices already include the surcharges.

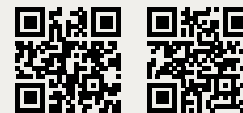
Swiss Travel Pass

The Swiss Travel Pass is the key to the Swiss public transport network. With a single ticket, you get to explore all of Switzerland by train, bus and boat for 3, 4, 6, 8 or 15 days. All sections of the Grand Train Tour of Switzerland are included, as is public transport in 90 towns and cities. On top of all this, there is free admission to over 500 museums throughout the country and discounts of up to 50% on mountain excursions.
