Bernina Express gets a makeover



The modernisation of the Bernina Express is progressing as planned.

The interior of all 26 panoramic coaches is currently being upgraded, and the compartments are being equipped with power outlets to enhance the travel experience on the Bernina Express even further. In addition, one compartment is being redesigned to provide more luggage storage – a clear advantage, especially for guests with larger amounts of baggage.

The modernisation of all panoramic coaches is scheduled to be completed by the summer timetable of 2025. This will make the Bernina Express even more attractive for travellers seeking to experience the spectacular landscapes of Switzerland on one of its most iconic panoramic trains.

Vigezzina-Centovalli Railway with new rolling stock for their 100-year anniversary



The Vigezzina-Centovalli Railway welcomed the first of eight new trains to its fleet last October. The latest-generation trains by Swiss manufacturer Stadler Rail combine comfort with innovation and can accommodate up to 142 people. Travellers with small children will appreciate the dedicated areas for families, while accessible areas meet the needs of wheelchair travellers. In addition, there's ample storage room for up to four bikes. An information system on each train provides guests with interesting insights about their journey in real time for a personalised travel experience.

Besides offering more comfort, the new trains results in more frequent connections on the Locarno–Intragna–Camedo stretch within Switzerland. In 2025, travellers from Locarno to Camedo can look forward to hourly connections. And in 2028, guests will benefit from two services per hour between Locarno and Intragna.
